A general discussion was held on the implementation of the Revised Regulations and Syllabus for B.A., English, M.A., English courses and Part II General English to take effect from the Academic Year 2022-23.

Suggestions on 'gender balance' in the syllabus 'Women Studies', prescribing texts written by women writers, inclusion of papers like 'Theatre and Communication' are discussed by Dr S. Armstrong and it was well received.

It was reported that three faculty members from the department are nominated for the Naan Mudhalvan Scheme of the Government of Tamil Nadu in initiating communication and job-oriented skill-based training in tie-up with many multinational companies.

The revised General English syllabus, framed by TANSCHE with a vision to equip the students to compete in this current global scenario, is adopted.

The Boards of Studies recommended undertaking projects in the unexplored arenas of literature and inclusion of papers like, Green Literature, Children Literature, Psychobiographical, Cultural Studies, etc, for the post-graduation projects to kindle the mind of students towards research.

The Board also recommended project and practice based internal assessment to bring out the creative and critical skills of the students.

The Board of Studies considered and approved the list of examiners for the ensuing theory examinations.
