Preamble:

Student Satisfaction Survey provides a means to assess student's perspective of Teaching-Learning process and a method for introspecting the structures and procedures of learning. The survey exhibits the degree to which student's expectations on Teaching-Learning are fulfilled by the Institution. The student satisfaction survey provides a mechanism for the Institution to decode the aspirational levels of the students and raise the bar high every year.

Common Instructions given to students:

- This survey is conducted via online only
- All the questions of this survey are designed by NAAC
- The link for online survey is kept permanently in the Institutional website.
- There are 20 objective type questions and students are instructed to answer to all the questions.
- There is a descriptive question at the end of the survey and students can give their suggestions and comments if any.
- Students are well informed about the link and they can fill it throughout the year.
- The inputs from the students are analysed by IQAC of the institution.
- Based on the feedback analysis, the suggestions for improvement are prioritized for immediate implementation.

Process:


The questionnaire is based on the scale where the responses are recorded on a scale of 1 to 5, with the most favourable response being rated as 5 and least favourable response being rated as 1. The responses registered for each question are evaluated to a mean score on a 5-point scale as calculated as below:

Mean score = $(5 \times \text{No. of responses in Excellent parameter} + 4 \times \text{No. of responses in Very Good parameter} + 3 \times \text{No. of responses in Good parameter} + 2 \times \text{No. of responses in Fair parameter} + 1 \times \text{No. of responses in Average parameter}) / Total No. of responses in All parameters.$


1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?








5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.





























Conclusion:

Majority of the students have expressed their opinion that the Teaching and Learning process is good. Students were appreciative of the teaching methodologies in place but suggested to undertake field trips for students.

As a whole 81% of the students are satisfied with the Teaching Learning Process, methodologies and procedures followed by the Institution.
